After my father's death, my mother returned to Colo. with her three younger children, in the latter days of Dec. 1914. The two older boys had come out in April. Our little school (pine wood) was a little over two miles from home. We three younger children tried riding burros to school for awhile, but we soon found out that we could keep warmer if we would walk. That is the way we went after that. It was mighty hard on our six year old sister to try to walk in our tracks in the deep snow, but we boys had no sympathy for her, so she either had to step in our tracks, or make some of her own. Maybe that helped to develop her self reliance, which she has had to use so much all of her life.

My mother kept us four boys working together for years--we milked a big bunch of cows and farmed around 200 acres--20 to 50 acres of certified seed potatoes, which were mostly trucked near Monte Vista and Alamosa--or North near Greeley and Fort Morgan. We got a sawmill in the 20's and during the winter months we did most of that kind of work, but during the 30's we boys started to marry off and that broke up the old home ranch. Having homesteaded and lived way back in the hills, I wanted something a little more level--so I took this land in the South end of the "OLD" prehistoric lake bed, which contained the fossil beds and petrified logs and stumps, some of which are 20 ft. in diameter. I have had a lot of pleasure in studying the formation of this lake bed, and digging in the fossil beds. We are now sold down to 1600 acres of our own land, altho we are leasing another 640 acres as pasture. We are not farming like we used to do. We have all the old fields planted to perennial grasses, some of which we cut for feed, also this sod will help hold the soil.

We have built several miles of diversion ditches--thirty or more erosion control dams, to help slow down some of the erosion which over grazing, logging and farming have helped produce. We have put rainbow trout in the dams, which were built on small streams, altho I do not do much fishing (I as author, had a delicious fish dinner while on my last visit). It is mighty nice to see others enjoying themselves catching them. I think our greatest accomplishment was the filling of the big wash out that went down thru the creek valley near our house. This wash would average sixty ft. wide and 3 to 4 ft. deep. This wash had drained the water out of the banks, so that nearly all the grass had died, and wasn't producing much vegetation. After filling this wash with the dirt from the sides, we now have a nice meadow which has been cutting over 1500 bales of good hay every year. This hay, with the fact that we cut off some of the old fields, makes it possible for us to winter around 50 head of beef cattle. We have a lot more pasture now than we have cattle to eat it, but this is the way we want it. We are building up a better stand and quality of grass which shows up real good now.

In the middle 30's things were mighty hard here on the ranch, so I took a job in the Cripple Creek Gold mines--at \$5.00 a day. I went underground and ran a machine drilling holes, loading them, and shooting them. I hated the handling of the dynamite, because it would always give me a nasty headache, but it was very interesting to study how the gold would be formed in the rocks, and dykes. Once in awhile we would get some real high grade rocks. They took out a fourth of a million dollars out of the vein which was overlooked years ago, when the mine was worked before.

The work wasn't too hard--the time really did go fast, but it wasn't too long before I found myself missing being out in the sunshine and the fresh air. So I never went back after I got out of the Hospital.

After living in Modesto for a few years, he changed his Church affiliation to the First Christian Church, and although he professed to not being a true Church member, he attended service twice on Sundays, to supply the bass for the choir. He had a very unusual voice, and his voice was so low that wooden floors would actually vibrate, when he sang. Once Chaliapin sang on the radio, and Dr. John sang along with him until the dramatic moment of Chaliapin's "low" note, then Dr. John sang two full notes below him. Dr. John was a very colorful and dramatic figure in Modesto. In his office, rather than a sterile waiting room, he put in a piano, and urged anyone who wanted to play ..to do it. I can remember his low, rumbley voice calling out from the treating room "Hey, anyone out there who wants to sing or play the piano, DO IT! It's too quiet." He had a very deep understanding of people and their problems, and never hesitated to answer a call for help. During the depression, he was often paid with a rabbit or two chickens, but that never stopped him from making a house call at 2 a.m. Modesto attested to this, at his funeral, by a large percentage arriving to say "Goodbye Dr. John." Physically he was a big "hulk" of a man. 6'2" and about 230#, but his tremendous hands were so gentle. There was a small area in his treating room that he covered with a black cloth, and in front of this, he would artistically arrange a fresh spray of his favorite flowers. His epitaph should read: "Here is a man who truly loved his fellow mankind."

James, a son of John P. and Esther (Baker) Snare, was born in Huntingdon Co., Pa., and attended school and worked on the home farm until thirteen years of age, when he was indentured to a tailor, who did not at all suit the young aspirant for this trade, so he was transferred to the shop of J. M. Gline, also a tailor, and a Dutch Winebrenarian preacher. He labored with this man 2 years, then entered the employ of John P. Gable, a tailor and Methodist class leader, later worked at his trade at Newburg, purchased an interest in the Kissinger Tailor shop which he held about 4 years. (Rebecca (Baker) Clark was a grand-daughter of Capt. John Baker of the war of 1812, who as a private, led a forlorn hope against the British, which resulted in victory for the patriots, and for which he was commissioned on the field.) Mr. Schnerr continued with the State Militia, held two commissions as First Lieutenant from Gov. Johnson of Pa., resigning, in the fall of 1852 and selling his business interests, he came to Penn township, Stark Co. purchased 60 acres on section 18, where he lived 5 years, when he traded home and tract for his brothers property, and in 1860, moved to his new farm of 116 acres on Sec. 7, to which he later added 197 acres, making a total of 315 acres. Stock farming and auctioneering replaced Tailoring with James Snare, as he was then known, the name being spelled since about 1836-1840. In politics, his first vote was cast for Fremont. In 1859, he was elected Justice of the peace which office he held many years. In 1886 he was elected supervisor, has served as school trustee, also as collector. For over 46 years he has been a member of the Methodist Protestant Church along with his wife. During the War of the Rebellion he belonged to the Union League, and helped to raise a Company, was elected Captain, but as more companies were offered than could be received, the members of this company went off and joined other companies, that were received.

We are told that John Snare was a very powerful young man. One of the stories of his strength has to do with his milking a cow that kicked. He grabbed her right hind leg, straightened it out, and went on milking with one hand.

John Snare, a well-to-do agriculturist resided on section 7, Penn township, has for half century been identified with the interests of Stark County and has materially aided in the development and prosperity of this region. He is a native of the Keystone state, born in Todd township, Huntingdon county, January 5, 1829, and comes of a family of German origin, who spelled the name Schnerr. His father, John P. Snare, was born in Maryland, July 18, 1795, but when a mere child went with his father, Peter Schnerr, to Pennsylvania, locating in Huntingdon county, where he grew to manhood and married Esther Baker, the mother of our subject, who died in that state, leaving six children, all of whom accompanied the father on his immigration to Illinois in 1847, at which time Nancy was married, being the wife of Alexander Kissinger, who also came with them. The father had also married again in Pennsylvania. From their old home they drove through to Wyoming, Illinois the trip occupying six weeks. It was their intention to locate in Whiteside county, but on reaching Urbana they learned that many horse thieves then infested the county, and these rumors were confirmed as they journeyed on; so that on arriving in Stark county they decided to settle there and purchased one hundred and sixty acres, comprising the north west quarter of section 18, Penn township.

John P. Snare, the father, became quite well-to-do, accumulating considerable land in Stark county, and continued to make his home there until called to his final rest in 1873. His remains were interred in Snareville cemetery. His second wife survived him many years, dying March, 1896. In early life he was a whig and later became a Republican. In Pennsylvania he had united with the Methodist Protestant Church, belonging to the Baltimore conference, and he was instrumental in establishing the church in Castleton, of which he, his wife and our subject were charter members. He had obtained a good common-school education, which he supplemented by extensive reading and was well informed upon the leading questions and issues of the day.

By his first marriage, John P. Snare had seven children, and by the second, five, of whom six are still living. One son, Cyrus Cooper, enlisted in Company E, One Hundred and Twelfth Infantry, under Captain Ottman, and served throughout the entire civil war, receiving a wound in the shoulder. After the war he married and moved to Minnesota, where he died near Bass Lake, leaving two children. James Snare, whose is next older than our subject, died in December 1896, leaving a widow and six children, and he was buried in Snareville cemetery. Joseph, who married and lived near Holden, in Johnson county, Missouri, at his death left four children.

Although afforded very limited opportunities for obtaining an education in his native state, Mr. Snare, of his review, made the most of his advantages, as he was studiously inclined, and on coming to Stark county taught the first school in Wyoming, it being conducted in a log house in the south east part of town. Among his pupils was Governor Thomas, of Soldiers' Home at Dayton, Ohio, and in after years the governor called our subject's attention to the fact that he once flogged him. Mr. Snare assured him, however, that he deserved it. His wages as a teacher were only ten dollars per month, and were used in the support of his family.

On attaining his majority, Mr. Snare started out in life for himself, buying on time two hundred acres of land on section 12, Toulon township, Stark county. Having secured a home he next wished some one to preside over it, and on March 4, 1854, he married Miss Mary T. Holgate, of Penn township, who was born in Luzerne county, Pennsylvania, and is a daughter of James and Sylvia (Trux) Holgate. He secured a good education and

successfully engaged in teaching for a time. Her father, who formerly lived for many years in Philadelphia, became a prominent man in this region, served as justice of the peace for several years, and also as county judge of Stark county. Mr. Snare has been very successful in his farming operations and now owns over five hundred acres in one body, lying partly in Penn and partly in Toulon townships. He removed to his present home in 1856, and in 1888 erected his comfortable and commodious dwelling, his former residence having been destroyed by fire in that year. It had contained lumber hauled by wagon from Chicago at an early day.

Of the children born to Mr. and Mrs. Snare, one died in infancy and another at the age of thirteen years, she being the first in the county to die of spotted fever. Wilden, a successful farmer of Stark county, was born December 29, 1854, and completed his education in the Peoria High School. He owns one hundred and ten acres in Penn and Toulon townships, and, possessing considerable musical talent, has successfully engaged in teaching singing-schools in the county. He married Miss Mary L. Hess, by whom he has one child, Merwyn, born in Toulon township, March 17, 1890. Wilna Paine is the widow of Matt P. Minsker, who died in November, 1896, leaving three children--Wilna Winifred, Frances Pearl, and Claude. Their other child, Nellie, died previous to the father's death. Mrs. Minsker now lives with our subject. Wilber, who completes the family, was born in 1863, married May L. Sherman and lives in Penn township. They have three children, Natalie, Viva, and Kent.

Reared a whig, Mr. Snare voted for Scott in 1852, but at the following presidential election supported John C. Fremont, and has since been an ardent republican. For one term he served as supervisor of Penn township, and was elected justice of the peace, but moved out of the precinct and consequently did not serve. Since twelve years of age he has been a faithful member of the Methodist Protestant church of which he has served as trustee for many years, and has assisted in building several houses of worship, not only for that church but for other protestant denominations. His oldest son belongs to the same church, but his daughter holds membership in the Methodist Episcopal church.

Merwyn lost his mother when he was still a child, and had the attention of a Stepmother from 3 yrs on. Not a very pleasant life and he struck out for himself when 16 yrs. old. He worked as a farm hand for awhile, then took up factory work, after which he started working for Northwestern Yeast Co. traveling thru Mass., New York, Pennsylvania, and Minnesota. This was very educational to him, and he learned the value of money better than he had any other time. While doing this work he was drafted for service in W.W. #1 trained in Camp Dodge, Iowa, went overseas with the 37th Div. of Ohio, was wounded in action in Flanders, and returned to the U.S. on Dec. of 1918. Again to the factories, where he served until about 1923 when he returned to Wyoming, Ill. where he engaged in small appliances sales and service. He was married the first time when 45 years old and fathered a daughter, Patricia. Was divorced in 1946 and remarried again later that year. He went to work in 1943 for Caterpillar Tractor Co. of Peoria, Ill. and stayed there until 1955 when he was retired. floral tributes entirely covered the casket. After the services at the church the body was laid to rest in the adjacent cemetery.

Kent was a person whom we all greatly admired for his manly qualities. And there is no language at our command whereby we can fittingly expressed the sincerity of the regret of his many friends, old and young, over his sudden and untimely death.
