James Isaac Snare, a son of David and Catherine (Evans) Snare, was born in Huntingdon County, Penna. His father was a carpenter, but died in 1823, while James Isaac was still a small child. James Isaac was raised on a Penna. farm, his education being very meager. In 1843 or 1845 he came to Licking County, Ohio, and the following year, returned to Pa. for his mother, who lived with them until her death.

In 1853 he came to Claiborne Township, Union County, and settled on a farm on 52 acres, where he resided until his death, taking the land in its wild state and improving it. When he first came to this township, he killed 13 deer and 48 wild turkeys in one winter.

In 1847 he married Phoebe Edwards of New Jersey, daughter of Ira and Ann (Evans) Edwards, by whom he had 7 children, listed above. The family are all members of the Methodist Episcopal Church and Mr. Snare voted the Republican Ticket. During his lone life in a new country, he has met with many narrow escapes of injury, and has frequently had his life placed in imminent jeopardy.

A BIRTHDAY SURPRISE

On Tuesday evening, Dec. 28th, while our old friend and neighbor Isaac Snare was quietly sitting in his chair in his parlor, he was happily surprised by the arrival of his children and neighbors, who, with well filled baskets gathered at the home of his son, George, and marched enmasse to the old gentleman's house where they quietly and in a jovial way were entertained. The young ladies and gentlemen, assisted by a few of the older heads, engaged themselves in an old way by reviving a few old-time plays.

After spending a couple of hours in this way, supper was announced, and this was another surprise to our friend, to see the bounties that were spread before him. The rest of the evening was spent in a very pleasing manner. After supper, your correspondent obtained the following bit of history from the host's own lips.

Isaac Snare was born in Huntingdon County, Pa. Dec. 28th, 1819, and is therefore sixty one years old. In 1845 he went to Licking County, Ohio, where he lived until 1853. In 1846 he married and after leaving Licking County he came to this County, where he purchased a farm of fifty acres in Claiborne Township, on which he has since lived.

Eight children have been born to him, seven of whom are living-five being present. Mrs. Edith Brady who resides in Marion County, and Mrs. Edith Quans, who lives in Kansas, were the two absent daughters.

The first fifteen years that he lived on his farm he cleared his land and did work for John T. Lenox to the amount of \$3,000.00. In the meantime he worked out one whole year and did work for his neighbors.

He has had some very narrow escapes. Once while digging a well, the bucket containing dirt was let fall on his back, which crippled him for quite awhile.

At another time, when he had been but two days in Union County, he was clearing off the ground about his cabin, and had built a heap of brush and logs, across which he felled a sugar tree. Immediately he began cutting down another - a beech - which fell across the stump in such a way as to cause Snare to step out of the way. He stepped upon the butt of the fallen sugar, and, not thinking of the danger he watched the falling tree, which fell across the top of the aforesaid sugar, which was nearly on balance. When struck it caused the aforesaid butt to fly upward in a manner which Snare could not escape, and as a matter of course, it sent him spinning into the air, so that when descending the tree was recoiling again, and met his falling body, which was the cause of his breaking three ribs and injuring his arm- from which he has at times been crippled.

The evening now being far advanced, and all having had a real picnic, they departed, each to his own home.

Weir, Ks.: Home of the Flyswatter

(Editor's Note: Wilma Cook Snare of Cherokee is recording for future generations the history of that area. Born and raised in Cherokee, Mrs. Snare has written and published a book giving the history of the town. She is currently working on a book about McCune and in her research has delved into the past of much of the area. She has offered to provide the Advocate with some of the fruits of her research. The following article concerns Weir and the invention of the flyswatter.)

In 1911 Dr. Samuel Crumbine, head of the Kansas State

Board of Health, went to a ballgame between Topeka and Wichita. He heard people yelling "sacrifice fly" and one man yelling "swat the fly." This gave him an idea.

Back in his office he put together a massive campaign with the slogan "Swat The Fly!" The catchy campaign attracted a lot of attention.

That's when Frank Rose, teacher and Scout Master at Weir, Ks. went to the W.J. Allen Drugstore and picked up some yardsticks. He then went to the lumberyard and bought some screenwire which he cut in squares. These squares of wire were nailed to the yardstick, which had been

cut in half, and they named them "Fly Bats". When Dr. Crumbine saw the invention he thought for a moment and said "Let's call it a flyswatter".

After the Boy Scouts had assembled all the flyswatters, nee Fly Bats, they gave two to each household.

They also enlisted the help of city officials and picked up trash, garbage and other items and hauled it away.

So, although Frank Rose left Weir and the teaching profession shortly afterwards to become a Forest Ranger in Colorado, he had put Weir on the map as the place where the flyswatter was invented.

Heart attack claims farmer

John W. Brady, Prominent Jackson Township resident, passed away very suddenly Saturday. A very sudden heart attack suffered at 6 a.m. Saturday morning, caused the death of John W. Brady, 59, at his home 3 miles north of Essex. He was a prominent and well known Jackson township farmer.

Mr. Brady was born 12th Nov. 1879 in Marion Co. a son of Wm. Brady and Edith Snare Brady. His father was a native of Ireland. Mr. Brady was united in marriage Mar. 17th, 1924, to Miss Maude Wynn.

Surviving is the widow, two foster children, Mrs. Ralph Eaches, of Richwood, and Miss Frances Roesbrough at home and two sisters, Mrs. Elmer Crane, Marion, and Mrs. Clarence Patterson, Richwood.

Rev. Williams conducted the funeral services Monday afternoon at the home. Burial in charge of S. R. Sanders was made in Otterbein cemetery.

Mrs. Edith Snare Brady. Once more a family tie is broken, and a whole community is bathed in tears, as with the spirit of sympathy it endeavors to share the deepest sorrow. Mrs. Edith Snare-Brady, a daughter of Isaac Snare and Phoebe, was born in Licking County, Ohio, June 5th, 1848. The family moved to Union County in 1853 and settled near the Finley church.

These early settlers helped to form the church in which Miss Edith was converted in the year 1870. At this time, she united with the Finley Methodist Episcopal Church.

In 1877 she was united in marriage to William Brady, with whom she lived a faithful and devoted wife, until her death came so suddenly Nov. 7th, 1906. Seven children were born to these parents; Margaret, Elsie, James, Ilo, Benjamine, and Irene Olive. Benjamine died in infancy, but the remainder live to bear testimony of a mothers patience, love and great eagerness for their well-being. Three sisters and one brother also survive her.

Mrs. Brady lived for a few years with her family near Green Camp, removing her church membership to that place, where she drew to her a host of friends and acquaintances. Four years ago they returned to the Finley neighborhood, when she returned her church membership to the church of her childhood. Everyone who knew this lady is full of praise for her beautiful Christian spirit, her pains taken in the comfort of her family, and her kindness to her neighbors and friends.

In the presence of a vast concourse of sorrowing friends the Funeral rites were observed under the directions of her Pastor, the Rev. H.V. McCleary of Green Camp, assisted by Rev. McKinnon of Essex. Mr. Brady bore the remains to the Price cemetery, where they were tenderly laid to rest, covered with a profusion of flower and family.

MRS. WILLIAM BRADY IS FOUND DEAD IN BED!

William Brady, a prominent farmer living five miles south of LaRue, awoke at 4-o-clock Wednesday, and found his wife, aged fifty-eight years, dead at his side. She had died a half-hour before the husband made the discovery. The death of Mrs. Brady came unexpectedly. Tuesday she had seemed in the best of health and was not only able to do her own work, but had gone to the home of a neighbor and helped in kraut making. She retired, Tuesday evening apparently in good health and spirits. She awoke during the night, and complained to her husband of having pains in her head, but the trouble was not regarded as serious.

Mrs. Brady spent practically all her life in Marion County, having lived near Green Camp before moving to near LaRue four years ago. She was held in high esteem by all of her acquaintances.

Mr. Brady and six children survive. The children are: Margaret, Irene Olive, John and James Brady and Mrs. Elmer Crane.

Coroner E.L. Brady was called Wednesday, and, after investigation, found death due to paralysis of the heart.

The funeral was held at the house, at one o'clock Friday afternoon, and was followed by interment in the Price cemetery.

WILLIAM BRADY

William Brady was born in Donegal, Ireland, Jan. 7th, 1842, and departed this life 19th Apr. 1919, aged 77 years, 3 months, and 12 days. He immigrated to this country in 1858, landing at New York City. Later Mr. Brady came to Ohio, and settled on a farm in Marion County, on the Marion and Delaware Pike. From there he removed to a farm near Green Camp, and later to his farm in Bowling Green Township, where he resided until the close of his life.

Mr. Brady was twice married, his first wife being Mary Ann Hill, of Middlesex, Ireland. One daughter, Mrs. Chas. Landon of Prospect, survives this union. Mrs. Brady died the 20th Feb. 1871. He was again united in marriage with Edith Snare, of Richwood, Ohio. To this union, seven children were born. One son, Benjamin, dying in infancy, and one daughter, Mrs. Margaret Bauer, at the age 28 years. Those living are John W., who lived with and made a home for his father, James I. and Mrs. Elmer Crain of Marion, Ohio, Mrs. Clarence Patterson and Mrs. Ralph Robertson, of Near Richwood.

Five grandchildren and one sister, Margaret Brady, Donegal, Ireland, also survives. Mr. Brady united with the Methodist Episcopal Church at Green Camp, while residing near that village and was transferred to the membership of the Finley M. E. Church later. He was most loyally devoted to his church and his God. He lived in vital touch with the Divine and was happy in the satisfaction his relation to God gave him. He was held in highest esteem by his brethren and his place will be sadly vacant.

In every neighborhood where Mr. Brady has lived, his name is as ointment poured forth. His old neighbors delight to honor his memory, for his life has been a real benediction to them all. But one place where his Christian character and graces have shown with the clearest lustre is in his home and among his children. There, of all places, was he missed the most. But what a rich heritage is theirs. The fine example of Christian living can never be forgotten, and the influence of his life can never be out-lived.

SAMUEL KISSINGER, Aitch, Huntingdon county, Pa., was born May 20, 1819, in Washington county, Md., son of George and Mary (Fry) Kissinger. George Kissinger was a native of Huntingdon county, of German descent. His wife, Mary (Fry) Kissinger, died when their only child, Samuel, was but three days old. The father and son were then separated, a member of the mother's family taking charge of the child. After some time, George Kissinger married again, but died when his son Samuel was about nine years of age, in Washington county, Md.

The relative who had taken Samuel Kissinger kept him until he was nine years old, when he was bound out by the Orphans' Court at Hagerstown, Md., to Isaac Clymer, cooper. Mr. Kissinger remained with his master until he reached his majority, attending school for only a short time, but learning his trade. Isaac Clymer removed from Maryland to Huntingdon county, Pa., when young Kissinger was fourteen. When he became of age Mr. Kissinger opened a cooper shop on his own account in Penn township, and worked at the trade continuously for twenty-five years. He began business with the small capital of ten dollars, and that was borrowed. By industry and economy, however, he succeeded in his enterprise, and was not long in repaying the loan in full. Later, he bought with his savings a little farm of 50 acres, cleared and improved it, and built upon it a frame house and barn. As he was able, from time to time he added to his farm, until now he owns more than 200 acres in Penn township, all under cultivation. He gives to this farm and to raising and dealing in stock his principal attention, but still works to some extent at his early vocation. Mr. Kissinger's success is an encouragement to all who may have their own way to make in the world, without other resources than their own simple determination to persevere, to work faithfully and act honorably. The same success is possible to all who use the same means. Mr. Kissinger, though a respected citizen, has never sought or held any public office. He is a Democrat.

Samuel Kissinger was married in Penn township in 1842, to Mary Snare, a native of Penn township. Their children are: Elizabeth, deceased; Delila J. (Mrs. Isaac Lampe), of Huntingdon, Pa.; Margaret, deceased, wife of W. Black, of Huntingdon; George, died young; Catherine, now housekeeping for her father; and Lucinda (Mrs. T. Martin), of Nebraska. Mrs. Kissinger died in Penn township in 1895. Mr. Kissinger is a member of the Methodist Episcopal church. He is a teacher in the Sunday-school. For seven years he held the position of superintendent.
