

Solo District.

A Copy of its Mining Laws.

Section 1. This District shall be known as Solo Mining District.

Section 2. Its boundaries are described as follows to wit;

Commencing at point at the northerly end of Cronese Lake and running thence Southerly to Mesquite Springs on the Ludlow road. Thence easterly to Marl Springs on the old Hardy Villa road; thence northerly to Highland Springs on the Ivanpah road; thence westerly to the north east corner of the Five Points District; Thence westerly along the south east side line of Five Points District to the place of beginning

Section 3. The mining Laws of the United States shall govern all locations of mining claims and mill sites made in this District.

Section 4. Locations made in this District subsequent to the adoption of these by laws, must be recorded in the District within twenty days after the date of such location and in the County Records on San Bernardino within the space of sixty days from date of location notice posted on said claim

Section 5. It shall be the duty of each locator of a mining claim in this district to build not less than six monuments of stone to properly mark his or their claim, viz; one at each corner of the claim and one at each centre end, which must be described in the location notice posted conspicuously

on the ground claimed. This Section does not apply to triangular or irregular claims or fractions of ground which have less than four corners.

Section 6. No locator of a mining claim in this district shall place or cause to be placed any mark or monument of any sort whatever upon the surface ground of any other claim for any purpose except the ground is owned by the same person or persons making such locations.

Section 7. The first assessment done under the mining laws of the United States in this district to constitute one hundred dollars worth of labor and improvements, must be a shaft or incline on each location, the dimensions of which must not be less than four by six feet, nor less than ten feet deep measured from the lowest surface rim of such shaft or incline, and that each year thereafter not less than the above amount of work must be performed on each claim whether by shaft, incline, open cut, tunnel or otherwise, and that this Section applies to all claims in this district after this date. Any locator of a mining claim in this district may sink a shaft or incline less in length and breadth provided he sinks an additional depth sufficient to equal a shaft or incline four feet wide by six feet long and ten feet deep to constitute the first assessment done on any location in this district

Section 8. It shall be the duty of the Recorder of this district to keep an alphabetical record of all claims recorded in the district at Solo Camp in a book or books marked A. B. C. etc, min-

to ing records of Solo Mining Camp district, and that said books be open to inspection at all reasonable times.

Section 9. The Recorder is responsible for the safe keeping at all times of the district records and shall deliver them to his duly elected successor at the expiration of his term of office.

Section 10. A recorder shall be elected by ballot on the second Tuesday in January of each year, whose term of office shall be one year.

Section 11. A fee of not more than one dollar may be charged by the recorder for recording each location or claim.

Section 12. The recorder shall not be absent more than ten days from this district during his term of office, unless a duly qualified deputy is left in his stead to perform all of his official functions.

Section 13. The Recorder shall keep a copy of these by laws conspicuously posted in his office in Solo Camp at all times.

Section 14. Resolved that the Secretary send a copy of these by laws to the Calico Print, with the request to publish the same and that he send an additional copy to the County Recorder at San Bernardino to be placed on the County Records.
