Moody LaRue

Mr. and Mrs. Hal Davis of Fairfax received word recently of the death of Moody LaRue of Las Vegas, Nev.

Dwight (Moody) LaRue was born Dec. 27, 1914 in Fairfax the son of Florabet Miller and Van LaRue and died at a hospital in Las Vegas Oct. 2, 1987.

He was reared by his grandmother in Fairfax where he attended school and graduated with the class of 1934. He was an employee of the Livermore Laboratory testing sight and had retired and had made many trips back to Fairfax in the past several years, attending the alumni banquets and visiting at the Davis home. He served in the Army Air Corps during World War II.

He was hospitalized and was undergoing triple heart by pass surgery when he died.

The body was cremated and the remains were brought to the Wilkup's Grove Cemetery, near Fairfax for burial.
